Research and Innovation at the Cyber-Defence Campus

Hardly a day goes by without a reported cyber incident in Switzerland. As our society and our national infrastructures are getting increasingly digital, cyberdefence has become a key priority of the federal government. As a result, the Federal Department of Defence, Civil Protection and Sport (DDPS) has created three years ago a Cyber-defence Campus which has the mission to better anticipate the cyber threats and to stay at the forefront of the cyber developments in Switzerland. In this talk, I will present this recent initiative and highlight individual research and innovation projects that are currently under investigation at the Campus. I will also present collaboration opportunities for researchers and students of the University of St. Gallen.

Vincent Lenders is the Director of the Cyber-Defence Campus at armasuisse. He completed his Phd (2006) and MSc (2001) in electrical engineering and information technology at ETH Zurich and has been postdoctoral researcher at Princeton University (2007). Before taking his role at the Cyber-Defence Campus, he has worked at armasuisse Science + Technology as a Researcher Program Director at the intersection between cyber security, artificial intelligence, networking and crowdsourcing. His contributions have appeared in more than 140 internationally peer-reviewed research publications and have been implemented in various systems of the Swiss Armed Forces. He is also co-founder and acts as a board member of the OpenSky Network and Electrosense Associations.
